Hagstrom Limited Warranty

The Hagstrom factory in Sweden is possibly the most technically advanced guitar factory in the world. Look at the machined parts, the assembly, or even the superb finish of any Hagstrom and you'll know what this means. But in another way, the Hagstrom factory is curiously old fashioned. Young guitar makers serve an apprenticeship at Hagstrom, watching, assisting, and learning beside older craftsmen. These men operate some very sophisticated machinery, but we think it is far more important that they are also capable of making a guitar from beginning to end entirely by hand.

The philosophy behind this approach to guitar making has an unusual and important result. Whether you choose the most economical or the most luxurious Hagstrom model, you will get *exactly* the same quality of workmanship. Trim, inlays, and electronic equipment may affect the price of a Hagstrom, but the basic musical quality is always there. Play any Hagstrom and you'll know what this means, and why we can offer this limited warranty:

The Hagstrom Limited Warranty is to the original purchaser of any Hagstrom Guitar or Electric Bass Guitar when purchased from an authorized Hagstrom dealer. All Hagstrom Guitars and Electric Bass Guitars are warranted to be free of defects in materials and workmanship for a period of five (5) years from date of purchase.

Damage to strings, tuning pegs and usual wear of frets is not covered by this limited warranty.

The Ampeg Company will be the sole judge as to the cause of damage or defect and will repair or replace the instrument under the provisions of this limited warranty only if the instrument is returned by the owner or authorized dealer to the Ampeg Company prepaid. Owner or authorized dealer should write for return authorization and instructions for returning to the Ampeg Company, P.O. Box 310, Elkhart, Indiana 46514, giving model, serial number of instrument and date of purchase, if known.

HG 800 Special Electric Guitar

There's good reason for calling this solid-body guitar the Special: it combines outstanding musical quality and workmanship at a moderate price. It has two high-efficiency anti-hum pickups, each with its own tone and volume controls. A 3-position switch gives you a choice of bright rock sound, a rounder, warmer tone for rhythm chords, or a lush blues quality. In combination with the tone controls, this switch gives you a virtually unlimited tonal range.

HG 803 Swede Electric Guitar

The Hagstrom Swede is one of the most coveted guitars in the world. It's so compact and easy to handle, it seems almost too small for the magnificent sound it produces. The two Hagstrom pickups — humbucking, sensitive, and efficient — are both activated by separate volume and tone controls, and by two 3-position switches. One switch is for tone — sharp, mellow, and deep — independent of the pickups in use. The second switch is for choice of pickups — lead, bass and rhythm. These provide a large variety of effects when used in combination with the tone control. Perfect intonation is made possible by the bridge, which allows for individual adjustment of each string both horizontally and vertically. The unusually slender neck can be

precisely adjusted with the patented Hagstrom H-design truss rod.

The bridge is adjustable for height and position, allowing fine tuning of individual strings.

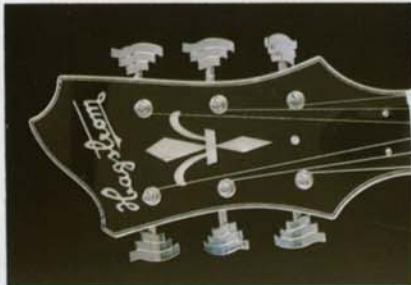


How Hagstrom Craftsmanship Improves Performance



Necks

Hagstrom necks are contoured with slender profiles for comfortable stretching and fast performance. Fingerboards are fitted with a full complement of nickel silver frets. Fret locations have been determined with mathematical precision for noticeably superior intonation.



Machine heads

Cut from Swedish steel, Hagstrom machines are sensitive, stable, and so precise you can feel their superior quality as you turn them.



H-rods

Hagstrom electric guitar necks are built with the patented H-design truss rod — so effective it's guaranteed to prevent twisting or warping of the neck. With an Allen wrench, you can adjust the neck quickly and easily without removing it.



Pickups

Powerful and sensitive Hagstrom double coil humbucking pickups. Each pole is individually adjustable for each string.



Woods

Richly grained mahogany and birch are carefully selected for acoustic quality. Fingerboards are of ebony or rosewood chosen for the density and close grain necessary to resist string wear.

Finish

Nobody knows more about fine wood finishes than the Swedes, and you'll never see a more appealing finish on any guitar. The flawless polyester finish not only highlights the color and natural beauty of the wood, but is also recognized to be the most durable of the available finishes.
